

KNOWLEDGE

Building a life in a different country means getting to know a new way of life, a different set of rules and rights and probably facing language barriers. We have the tools and knowledge to help you find your way, understand your rights and access support.

We have in-house experience on housing, healthcare, interacting with the government and so on. We have the tools and information to help you Whether it's housing, healthcare, contracts, or local services – we're here to help you find the answers.

With the FNV we can inform and advise you regarding working and living in the Netherlands.



CHANGE

Because knowledge and community are not enough on their own. Change does not come out of the blue. By working together we organise influence on the policies that matter!

We stand up together for change regarding housing, social integration, workers rights, dealing with stereotypes, and so on.

We want to see real improvements in how migrant workers are treated – in housing, employment, and in society. We work together to raise our voices, speak to local government, and push for policies that respect and protect all workers.

- → Formed out of shared needs, shared experiences, and a shared belief in fairness, dignity, and community.
- → Having the FNV at our back means we have the experts, will, guidande and networks to provide support and make a difference.
- → As migrant workers we want to be treated the same as any other resident of our city. We want and deserve to be a member of Tilburg society, with a good home, and a decent job.
- →In our community we help each other out. We provide each other with answers to questions about work and life in the Netherlands. We support each other in getting the rights and claiming the respect that we deserve.

WHY ARE WE HERE?

- → To make sure Tilburg is not only inclusive in words, but also in practice.
- → To provide community, help, tools and knowledge to people finding their way in the workforce and their life in Tilburg.
- → Building a life in a different country means getting to know a new way of life, a different set of rules and rights and probably facing language barriers.
- → Our main focus is to improve the living conditions of migrant workers particularly those coming through (temporary work) agencies.
- → We believe that no one should have to face the challenges of living and working in a new country alone. From housing issues and health insurance, to unfair treatment at work or simply navigating the Dutch system we've faced these things too. And we know that together, we're stronger. Our community stands on three pillars: Community, Knowledge and Change.


WHO ARE OUR MEMBERS?


- → A very diverse group of people from different walks of life, age groups, nationalities, educational and professional backgrounds. EVERYONE is welcome!
- → Diversity is our strength but our common needs unite us: decent housing, fair work, access to services, and recognition as full members of society.
- → Most members have either been in a similar situation themselves as labour migrants or have heard about it and want to help support or fix the problems.

HOW ARE WE STRUCTURED?



- → We are without hierarchy in our community, we have a horizontally organised structure.
- → The FNV is our power & funding.Our representatives have a budget and time allowance for working on our projects.
- → We have a member joining process, for those who want to help in providing support.
- → When members hear of problems or are approached by acquaintances about issues, the member informs the group and the hive mind sets about solutions using our knowledge centre, FNV resources or knowledge of who/where to go to for support.




